- > To establish linkage with reputed institutes of Gauhati City for academic excellence of students & their placement.
- ➤ To motivate student to participate in Inter-College, State, National & International sports & cultural events.
- Career Guidance Cell needs to be activated to increase the success rate of student in competitive exam & their placements
- ➤ Priority to be given on the introduction of Add-on, Certificate and other Skill development courses.
- > To prepare a database of all passed out students which will be helpful in career counselling & guidance & also in their placement.
- ➤ The IQAC should play a dynamic role in initiating quality enhancing measures.
