Facilities Available

College Library

The major centre of the college that sparks the learning atmosphere is the library of the West Guwahati Commerce College. The library is renamed after the local social worker Mr. Narayan Chandra Bharali. He was the founder member of West Guwahati Commerce College.

The Library is housed in second floor building of about 6000 sqr.ft. The library is serving the needs of about 1700 readers consisting of Teachers, Staff and students of Higher Secondary, B.Com and others. Its total collection of reading materials amounts to ten thousands including textbooks, general books, reference books, Journals etc. The collection is regularly updated with the most recent publications to offer students a wide selection of academic materials. The library is automated using the internet and the library management system KOHA.

The 'Book Bank' facility where the donated books are added and there is a distinct competitive section with varied reading materials for competitive exams. The Library is expanding its access to electronic and digital resources through Digital Library (DL). The student who makes the best use of the library is also given the "BEST READER AWARD" by the institution. Circulation services, reference services, reading room services, periodicals services, OPAC services, Internet services, E-Resource services, Wi-Fi-based library and other key services are also provided by the library.

Canteen

- 2. No application form will be accepted after the last date as notified and all incomplete application forms will stand automatically rejected.
- 3. The college follows the Reservation policy of the Government and the segregation of seats as per quota are: SC 7%, ST (Hills) 5%, ST (Plains) 10% OBC / MOBC 15%, Physically Disabled 2%, Extra Curricular Activities 2%, Freedom Fighter 2%.
